Unit 3 - Paperwork

In case you thought that Paperwork is not really required when going for a simple walk in the bush with some club members, how do you intend to notify those members, and the Club, that you are offering to lead a walk?

In this course we will refer to the paperwork involved for leading a walk.

Paper work for every walk covers:

- Walk description and grading
- Club members registration form
- Map and walk notes

Additional paperwork can include:

- BWV track clearing / maintenance request form
- Walk or trip report for newsletter
- Incident report form
- Application for temporary membership (Acknowledgement of risk)
